Formation for an Engaged Church:

Theological Education and the Resourcing of Discipleship

How does the theological education and training that we provide relate to the diversity of Christian discipleship in the world – to the wide range of vocations and forms of ministry, service and witness to which Christians are called in their homes, workplaces, communities and the public sphere? How well do we train ministers who will enable and resource the full breadth of Christian discipleship? Will it take a culture change for our churches to take this variety with full seriousness – and, if so, what role might theological education play in that? In what ways can we as theological educators better serve a church fully engaged in the world?

The 2018 Joint Conference is designed to be a space for all this, and more.

Speakers will include: **Megan Seneque**, (Susannah Wesley Foundation), **Revd Dr Stephen Spencer** (Director for theological education in the Anglican Communion), **Revd Dr Malcolm Brown** (Director of Mission and Public Affairs, Church of England), **Jenny Moberly** (Durham University) and **Brother Sam** (The Society of Saint Francis).

There will be a range of discussions and workshops on the conference theme and a chance to find out about the latest developments in practice and research from around our networks

The conference is a joint meeting of the Common Awards Staff Conference, the Theological Educators' Network, and the Ministry Development network. Bookings are handled only by Durham University.
